RUSSELL PROPOSES A SERIES OF FORUMS; HILGENBERG STAYS SILENT

SAUK CITY – Sauk City, WI - With less than two months remaining until the fall elections, Representative Steve Hilgenberg has remained silent on the opportunity to share his views with the citizens of the 51st Assembly District.

In a letter dated August 26th, Nathan Russell invited Representative Hilgenberg to participate in a series of forums to help voters of the 51st understand views held by each of the candidates. The letter proposed five potential locations with tentative dates, leaving dates, format and moderators open for discussion. To date, Representative Hilgenberg has remained apathetic with no response to the letter from Russell.

“Allowing voters to make informed decisions is critical to the democratic process. This district has a long tradition of open forums and idea sharing. I am disappointed in his lack of concern for providing information to area voters and hope he reconsiders our proposal,” stated Nathan Russell, challenger for the 51st Assembly seat.
